What skills will you gain?

You will gain an understanding of childcare and the role of various professionals within a childcare setting. You will consider play and development and consider their role in childcare and working in an early education setting at a more advanced level.

Entry requirements?

You must have obtained three National 4 passes including a literary subject, demonstrate an interest in working in a childcare setting and have a satisfactory reference.

How and where will I study?

You will study through face to face delivery at North Highland College UHI Alness campus. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction, then from August on Fridays from 9.45am to 2.15pm.

Where will it take me?

On attainment, you can progress onto the National Qualification Social Services: Children and Young People or National Qualification Health and Social Care, SCQF level 6 or study further school link subjects at Higher level at North Highland College UHI.

How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
