### What skills will you gain?

You will learn why people use the care services and develop the knowledge and values required for working in care practices such as nursing, health care, social care and childcare.

### Entry requirements?

You must have obtained a National 4 pass in a literary subject, demonstrate an interest in working with the health and social services sector and have a satisfactory reference.

### How and where will I study?

You will either study through face to face delivery with lecturers or a blended delivery which includes online and face to face with lecturers.

You will study at North Highland College UHI Alness campus. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction and then from August on Tuesdays from 9.00am to 1.15pm.

### Where will it take me?

On completion you can progress onto the NQ Health & Social Care, NQ Social Services: Children and Young People, HNC Childhood Practice, HNC Social Services, BA (Hons) Child and Youth Studies, BA (Hons) Health and Social Studies at North Highland College UHI.

### How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
