## What skills will you gain?

You will learn about child development from pre-birth to age eighteen alongside the roles and responsibilities of practitioners, other professionals and parent/carers contributing to the development of children and young people. You will look at child development, services for children and young people and childcare and development. This course is a good choice if you are interested in working in the childcare sector or planning to study towards a career in the sector including primary teaching.

## Entry Requirements?

You must have obtained a National 5 pass in English or another literary subject, demonstrate an interest in the sector and have a satisfactory reference.

## How and where will I study?

You will either study through face to face delivery with lecturers or a blended delivery which includes online and face to face with lecturers.

You will study at North Highland College UHI Alness campus. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction and then from August on Wednesdays from 9.00am to 1.15pm.

## Where will it take me?

On attainment you can progress onto the NQ Social Services: Children and Young People, HNC Childhood Practice or the BA (Hons) Child and Youth Studies at North Highland College UHI.

## How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
