SVQ Level 1



What skills will you gain?

This introductory hospitality course will give the opportunity to work in the restaurant and the kitchen of the North Highland College UHI's Burghfield House, to see what it is like to be a chef or a customer service member of staff.

Entry requirements?

You must be working at National 4 level, have an interest in becoming a chef or hotel manager and have a satisfactory reference.

How and where will I study?

You will study through face to face delivery at North Highland College UHI's training hotel, Burghfield House in Dornoch. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction, then from August on a Friday.

Where will it take me?

On completion you may be able to progress onto National 5 Hospitality as a school pupil or SVQ Level 2 Professional Cookery or SVQ Level 2 Hospitality as a full-time student at North Highland College UHI.

How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
