How and where will I study?

Delivery starts in June with a one day induction, then from August at a day and time to suit your individual timetable. Classes are available on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays; please indicate your preferred day on your application form.

Where will it take me?

On completion, you can progress onto HNC Music Performance or apply to study BA (Hons) Applied Music at North Highland College UHI.
