What skills will you gain?

You will be introduced to the scientific study of human behaviour and the psychological explanations of it. You will look at different concepts, theories and approaches towards human behaviour and explore how sleep, dreams, stress, research, conformity, obedience and prejudice affect them.

Entry requirements?

You must have obtained a National 5 pass in English at A or B, demonstrate an interest in studying human behaviour and have a satisfactory reference.

How and where will I study?

You will either study through face to face delivery with Psychology lecturers or a blended delivery which includes online and face to face with Psychology lecturers.

You will study at North Highland College UHI Alness campus. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction and then from August on Fridays from 9.45am to 2.15pm.

Where will it take me?

On completion you can progress onto the National Qualification Social Services: Children and Young People or National Qualification Health & Social Care, SCQF level 6 or study further psychology including BSc (Hons) Psychology at North Highland College UHI.

How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
