What skills will you gain?

Pupils will build on the skills learned on SVQ Level 1 Hospitality to develop vocational skills and knowledge, and gain practical experience in menu planning; preparing, cooking and presenting a range of foods in a professional kitchen; serving food and drinks; undertaking reception duties and customer care; and planning, organising and running a small hospitality event.

Entry requirements?

You should have attained SVQ Level 1 Hospitality and have a satisfactory reference.

How and where will I study?

You will study through face to face delivery at North Highland College UHI's training hotel, Burghfield House in Dornoch. Delivery starts in June with a one day induction, then from August on a Friday.

Where will it take me?

On successful completion, you will be eligible to apply for either SVQ Level 2 Professional Cookery or SVQ Level 2 Hospitality as a full-time student at North Highland College UHI.

How do I apply?

The senior phase programme offered at North Highland College UHI is embedded in your option choices at school. Once you have decided on the course you would like to apply for, please speak to your Guidance Teacher who will advise you on how to apply. We will not interview you for this course, so ensure you complete all sections on the application form, paying particular attention to your personal statement.
