PROGRAMME TITLE: CONSTRUCTION CRAFTS, SKILLS FOR WORK

Programme Outline

Students will develop the skills, knowledge and attitudes needed for work in the construction industry. The course provides an insight into several important construction trades (bricklaying, decorative painting, carpentry and joinery, electrical and plumbing) and covers a variety of skills in trade specific units, helping learners to make informed choices regarding a career in construction. Learners will also develop skills and attitudes that enhance employability, which can be practised and developed across all the units in the course not just for the construction industry, but employment in general (eg setting goals, reflecting and learning from experience).
